Prerequisite: Intermediate sewing skills

Make a perfectly fitting pair of panties using Monica's Bravo Bottoms panty pattern with three style options. Although you will be using Monica's pattern in class, she will also show you how to copy your favorite pair of panties (without taking them apart!).

Students must bring a sewing machine with a straight and zig-zag stitch, a universal needle size 9-11 or a stretch needle size 11, basic sewing supplies and an extension cord.

*Kit includes Bravo Bottoms panty pattern and all materials to make a pair of panties including tricot, lace, elastic and thread.
